**Dr. Arif Cekic, P.E. - Manager Geotechnical Services, Professional Service Industries, Inc.**

Dr. Cekic is a licensed professional engineer in the State of Michigan with --fifteen years of experience in geotechnical engineering instrumentation, geotechnical engineering design, and construction materials testing and observation and is the Geotechnical Department Manager overseeing PSI's geotechnical operations. Dr. Cekic served as project principal for over 50 geotechnical instrumentation projects including Vibration Monitoring, Vertical Inclinometers, Extensometers, Settlement Plates, Vibration Wire Piezometers and Telltales in the states of Michigan, Ohio, New York, Illinois, Pennsylvania and Texas. Nature of the projects varied from single story historical structures to precast concrete water storage tanks.

**Kevin F. Dubnicki, P.E. - Project Specialist, Professional Service Industries, Inc.**

Kevin is a licensed professional engineer in the State of Michigan with ten years of experience in vibration monitoring and geotechnical engineering instrumentation practices. ## USPAP Reminder

### USPAP Update:

For appraiser members, please be advised we are now working under the new 2012-2013 Edition of USPAP. Chapter 7 will be presenting the 7-hr. update as the educational offering for the 2012 Fall Seminar at Shanty Creek in Bellaire, MI. However, if your appraiser license expires in July 2012, you may need to take the update before then. Appraisers requiring this module before August 1<sup>st</sup> can check other resources such as, the Great Lakes Chapter of the Appraisal Institute or Holloway Institute in Lansing. Otherwise, plan to attend Chapter 7's scheduled class this fall.

### Highlights of some of the changes include:

- Revisions to the definition of "Client", "Extraordinary Assumption", and "Hypothetical Condition".
- The definition of "Exposure Time" has moved from Statement 6 to the Definitions.
- Creation of the Record Keeping Rule which is part of the Ethics Rule.
- Revisions to the development and reporting of the Exposure Time Opinion.
- Revisions to Standard Rules regarding signed Certification requiring an appraiser to disclose any prior services performed on the subject within the past three years. This disclosure is not limited to appraisal services but includes any services performed. For example, if an appraiser mowed the lawn at the subject property within three years of the report date, it must be disclosed.

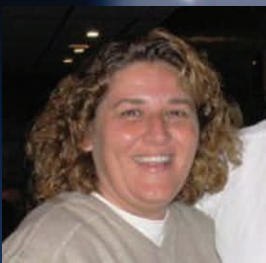

## Appraisal Opportunities-State of Michigan

Since 1922 DNR has received roughly 2.4 million acres of tax reverted land. The vast majority of (2.2 million) were acquired in 1939-1942 after a moratorium on foreclosures from 1933-1938 and the Great Depression – an unsettling parallel to today! For the past several years the department has worked hard to cull out those parcels that do not meet recreational or conservation goals for public use and have offered the surplus land (mostly recreational) for purchase by the public. To that end, you may be interested in subscribing to updates to DNR land for sale and also visit the **Land for Sale NOW** link at [http://www.michigan.gov/dnr/0,1607,7-153-10368\\_27230---,00.html](http://www.michigan.gov/dnr/0,1607,7-153-10368_27230---,00.html).

Additionally the Department maintains a list of State Certified General appraisers with a demonstrated background of producing credible reports for corridors, conservation easements, timbered land, waterfront, large land tracts, etc. If you know of anyone that might want to be considered, they should send in a redacted demonstration report to Valerie Lafferty, (laffertyv@michigan.gov). Not surprisingly, most of the work is in the recreational, northern areas of Michigan, but not always. All appraisals are bid through [www.bid4Michigan.com](http://www.bid4Michigan.com) now. So interested appraisers must sign up on [www.bid4Michigan](http://www.bid4Michigan.com) where all appraisal opportunities are posted for work with State of Michigan and other governmental entities as well.
